BMCC RELOCATES A PIECE

The Borough of Manhattan Community College leased 16,460 sf for its Center for Continuing Education and Workforce Development at 45 John Street. After Sept. 11, 2001, when the college was damaged, this center moved to Harlem. A portion of the new space is on a sublease.
